### 1. President's Report

- **a.** Village Green Trail Project NKHP will be supporting the Kingston Village Green Trail Project by providing a mechanism for funding.
- **b.** Kitsap Forest & Bay Coalition thinking about next steps in light of the recent property purchase.
- **c.** Meeting with Rob Gelder, County Commissioner, on Tuesday, April 24 at 3:15 PM at Coffee Oasis in Poulsbo to talk about next steps for the STO.
- **d.** Greater Peninsula Celebration next Thursday, April 26 at Kiana Lodge.

## 2. Vice-President's Report

- **a.** Sound to Olympics (STO)— The Bainbridge Island city council voted 4-3 to accept a crossing instead of a bridge at the Vineyard Lane intersection.
- **b.** The STO effort could benefit from building a coalition with other non-motorized community groups. NKTA may hold a separate meeting to rally additional community support.

## 3. Kitsap Peninsula Water Trails

- **a.** Greater Peninsula Conservancy has received funding for improving access to waterway in Port Gamble.
- **b.** Continue to work on posting site signs and improving launch and road-end sites.

## 4. North Kitsap Heritage Park Stewardship Group

- **a.** New PGHP trail map is being completed with information about the park on the back.
- **b.** The beaver receiver needs an overhaul as it keeps getting clogged due to beaver activity.
- **c.** Geocachers are placing caches within the park boundary, too many people going off trail. A potential solution is to remove caches if they are found.

## 5. Port Gamble Heritage Park

- **a.** Work on the shoreline trail to proceed on two dates, National Trails Day, Saturday, June 2, and United Way Day of Caring on Friday, June 22, both from 9 AM 1 PM, meet at the Bayview parking lot on the shore side.
- **b.** The new PGHP trail map is nearly complete and will include information about future logging activity.
